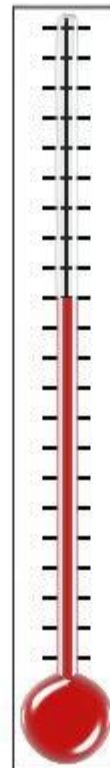
Parish Center Fund Campaign

Despite weather setbacks, construction is moving along! Yeah! In addition to building our new Parish Community Center and renovating our current Social Hall into Parish Offices and meeting spaces, since we have gone over our goal, we have contracted to add even more parking spaces up to a total of 400, more underground drainage systems, larger detention pond for rain runoff, building a pavilion and moving the playground to the west field, larger septic system, an enhanced kitchen, an integrated technology and security system for all three buildings. This takes care of concerns that would have needed to be addressed in the next building phase when we add transepts to our current church building. Any overage collected will go the church expansion phase.
