The next steps for our Parish Center:

- Electric to lights in the west parking lot
- Insulate exterior walls...first floor & basement
- Add new gas line
- Continue light gage metal framing on the interior
- Install TYVEK membrane
- Complete brick work
- Pour west ramp to kitchen entrance
- Complete dumpster pad and move dumpsters
- Rough in plumbing in the first floor and basement
- Install sump pump
- Install membrane roof
- Rough in electric in the first floor and basement

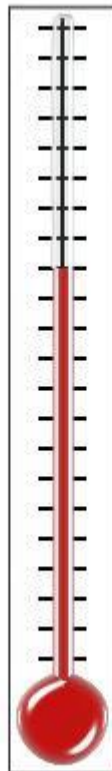
