- start sanitary and septic

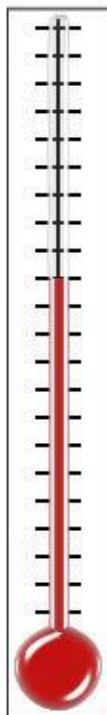
Shelter House
