St. John Neumann Parish Policy on School Support

Diocesan guidelines recognize the right of a parish with a school to receive the full per pupil cost for educating a non-parishioner in its school. The cost is calculated by dividing the total cost of operating the school for one year by the number of students enrolled during that year.

Part of this cost is defrayed by tuition. The remainder is billed to the home parish of each student.

St. John Neumann Parish *does pay* the assessed subsidy for students from first grade through high school provided that:

1. The family is a registered and active member of the parish, contributing to the annual offertory program in an identifiable way (EFT, envelope, check) and in an amount equal to the subsidy. Additionally, the family should attempt to give to the offertory in excess of the subsidy, as a means of supporting the daily operations and ministries of the parish. However, if there is some sort of financial hardship and the family is not able to contribute to the full amount to the offertory, please contact the pastor for a meeting. St. John Neumann will not withhold support if there is financial hardship.
2. The family fills out this Subsidy Agreement Form, signs it, and returns it to parish in the spring of each year. This allows the parish the benefit of including the amount of the subsidy into its projected budget for the coming fiscal year, starting July 1st of each year. The parish needs to know if it will be offering support for the coming academic year. If the family does not return this form for budget inclusion, they may not be able to receive support, since there will be no amount budgeted for them.
