- run electric to septic system
- light gauge metal framing basement & first floor
- hang drywall on one side of walls in basement & first floor
- install temporary front entrance
- caulk windows and install glass
- install ductwork basement & first floor
- install roof curb for kitchen
- frame in A/V room
- install grating in basement window wells

Watch for opportunities to tour the construction site!

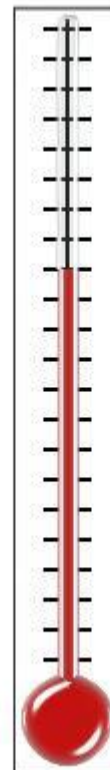
Parish Center Fund Campaign
